particular the thesis demonstrates that the standard pattern of vulnerability and household responses to drought is similar to that in the context of exogenous counter insurgency warfare while a different pattern of vulnerability and household responses to endogenous shocks such as endogenous counter insurgency warfare is identified Specifically the thesis surprisingly finds a positive link between level of vulnerability and initial high level of household wealth in the context of endogenous counter insurgency warfare A future research agenda in the area of vulnerability might need to focus on developing a greater understanding of the nature and characteristics of risk events such as endogenous shocks
