DNA is the hereditary molecule—passed from parents to offspring—that serves as the instruction manual for “building” each individual. DNA is found in the nucleus of almost every cell in our body. Forensic scientists can, therefore, collect DNA evidence from many different types of crime scene evidence, such as semen, saliva, skin cells, blood, and hair. This DNA can then be used to positively identify a perpetrator or exonerate accused suspects of a crime.

Roy Brown was convicted by junk science, the only “evidence” linking him to the crime was his teeth, and bite mark analysis is notoriously unreliable. Other types of physical evidence, such as hair samples examined under a microscope, are also problematic because they are not distinct enough to positively identify the individual from which they come. DNA is valuable in forensics because it is unique to each individual. DNA’s structure is the key to its uniqueness in each individual.
