find all the references to training So to help employers safety and health professionals training directors and others with a need to know OSHA s training related requirements have been excerpted and collected in this booklet Requirements for posting information warning signs labels and the like are excluded as are most references to the qualifications of people assigned to test workplace conditions or equipment It is usually a good idea for the employer to keep a record of all safety and health training Records can provide evidence of the employer s good faith and compliance with OSHA standards Documentation can also supply an answer to one of the first questions an accident investigator will ask Was the injured employee trained to do the job Training in the proper performance of a job is time and money well spent and the employer might regard it as an investment rather than an expense An effective program of safety and health training for workers can result in fewer injuries and illnesses better morale and lower insurance premiums among other benefits
